

The Barony of Settmour Swamp has been invited to participate in this fundraiser for the local 4H student exchange program. This will be our fifth year of partnering with them to build it into a premier event for Northern and Central New Jersey.

What: We are looking for volunteers and coordinators for the following: Heavy Weapons, Fencing, Thrown Weapons, Archery, Dancing and Singing, Fiber Arts, Calligraphy, Blacksmithing, etc. Any period art, craft or activity that lends itself to having the fair goers try it out would be especially desirable (obviously that does not include the martial arts, those they can watch). Only

period tents, period furniture and accoutrements will be allowed on the fairgrounds or items that are well disguised. This is to be an educational endeavor as well as an entertaining one

Founding of the Barony of Settmour Swamp & First Events by Ursula

The <u>first meeting</u> of what would become the Barony of Settmour Swamp occurred on August 4, 1979. At that meeting, Lady Ursula of North Woods was named the first Seneschale and, shortly after, Ursula published the first issue of what would become the Mudpuppy newsletter. Magda z Stalburg had volunteered to autocrat Visevald and Embla's Coronation (October 6, 1979, A.S. XIV), so the Swamp immediately burst onto the scene with a spectacular event.

The Shire of Settmour Swamp was officially formed on January 19, 1980. The Swamp prospered, and after little over 2 1/2 years we were recognized as the Barony of Settmour Swamp with Magda z Stalburg as our first Baroness.. Ursula's history of those first few years is available on the Barony website. At the time, Merowald De Seveastem periodically created paper maps of the Known World. He later commented that it was the only time that a previously unknown group was added to the map as a Barony.

We held monthly populace meetings called "**Swamp Stomps**". These were informal gatherings designed to bring everyone together for food and fellowship. The officer's meetings were also held at the Stomps.

The <u>first MudThaw</u> occurred on March 1, 1980 (A.S. XIV,) this event was notable for the WIZ-OFF" (a magicians competition) and belly dancing by Magda.

The <u>first Amber Kern</u> (November 1, 1980, A.S. XV), was held at the graduate hall of Princeton University. We were able to secure this fabulous medieval hall because Gershom Ibn Zabara was a graduate student in astronomy at Princeton. The Amber Kern was notable for the Hans Sachs play the "Hot Iron" and also for the smoke that filled the hall due to the blocked chimney.

The **Barony of Settmour Swamp** was announced, with Magda invested as the first Baroness, at the Coronation of Siegfried and Wanda on April 4, 1981 (A.S. XV). The investiture was slightly amusing due to the tiny coronet that Heinrich had constructed (about 4 inches in diameter). The highlight of the event was knife fighting in the main hall, inspired by the visiting Tuchux. Fur-clad Tuchux and elegant ladies fought each other one on one, with knives, to the cheers of the encircling crowd.

Ursula was invested as the second Baroness in January, 1982 at Bellringer's in Carillion, where Ursula also won the Liar's contest with a rendition of How the Swamp Ladies Won Pennsic. (No Fudge, there we were ...)

The **first Quest** occurred after Elysende and Gwenyth merch Llewellyn attended a Tuchux event and experienced a Tuchux Quest. The first Quest for Wit and Wisdom was held on May 28-30, 1983 (A.S. XVII), at Katherine of Edge's family's sheep farm. The first Quest was notable for the rain and the mud and the sheep droppings. It was wonderful.

Favorite Memories of the Swamp

Lady Ceara MacKieran: It was my first event. I don't even remember where it was held.... all I remember is that it was the Coronation of Gavin and Sedalia. I attended with my friends Emily and Stacee, and we were FLOORED when we heard the sound of a trumpet. All heads turned to the back of the hall, where dancing girls came floating in, followed by a host of guards and retainers... and finally, <u>a</u> man wearing a coronet, carried on a palanquin, throwing gold coins to the populace to the sound of loud cheering. It was Baron Irik, and all I could think was, "I want to be a part of THAT." Note: the event was Gavin and Sedalia's Coronation April 16, 1988 (AS XXII)

There was a Stomp when Bheithir broke my parents' front steps.

Gershom Ibn Zabara was a Swamp fighter and proudly wore the Swamp heraldry. At his **Doctoral Defense**, he appeared in a proper suit and tie, covered by his swamp tabard. He strode before the defense committee, drew his sword and declared, "I am here to defend my thesis". He was awarded his PhD. (Mudpuppy, September 1983)

Gwenhwyvar Telynores, called Jenna (Jenn): The moment that I knew the Swamp was my home went like this: 1985 or so, I was in high school with Wilhelm Van Utrecht. He told me about some people he met who liked to do 'medieval stuff - a bit like D&D'. But they ACTUALLY DID stuff - they didn't just talk about it. So I went to a couple of Swamp Stomps, and liked the people. Baroness Ursula was one of the first. But the real moment that 'The Dream' hit me - was at an event sometime either that year or the next that took place at **Lambert Castle** on Garret Mountain. EVERYTHING came together: the atmosphere, the people, the weather, EVERYTHING. Lords and Ladies strolled arm-in-arm on the lawns, music played, a great feast was cooked, and a bunch of us went horseback riding through the woods. Someone EVEN brought KITTENS!! I distinctly remember sitting on the lawn as the sun began to set, looking over the view down the mountain, the summer breeze playing with my hair, the music wafting down, and I let out a huge sigh and thought, "THIS is it. THIS is me. THIS is where I belong."



Favorite Memories of the Swamp

Merlinia: I brought The Book of Conquests to War to read to Bheither, and they liked "<u>The Hurling Match of Magh Nia</u>" the best.

So I researched Hurley, and got Irik to cut out 2 sticks from wood. Next year at War, I taught a Hurley class and got only Calum. We made more sticks for the next War, did another class, and got most of Bheithir, and some others. The first War Hurley class was pretty memorable. We were playing back to camp, and the ball went into the Land-agent's camp. There were lots of Muckety mucks there having coffee. Oops. So I smiled at them all, & asked "May we play through?" And we did.

Galen started making sticks, we played "<u>Tall vs Small</u>" at events, especially Quest, and "Us vs Them" at War & other events. The best (for me) being "<u>US vs Carillion</u>", where I got my one and only praise from Irik, when I went over backwards to stop the goal.

I told the guys I was not playing Goal when I turned 45, so we got Teric to be Goalie, and Elvira to manage the team.

That's when we got the nice shirts.

Favorite Memories of the Swamp

It was 1984, at the Second Quest, the "Quest for the Missing Monk"

There was a contingent up from Carillion including Bambina, an ex-patriot Brit who was "hiding out" in Carillion for a bit.

Anyway, the rains had come and washed the site repeatedly. The coolers and the beer keg had been washed away, down the river, in a flash flood and would not be found for some months after. So there we were, soaking wet, and telling jokes, and folks kept on going out to the local **IGA** for supplies. This became **journeying to the temple of the great god IGA** and pleading for food. And everyone came back with a watermelon.

Shortly after, the Watermelon Tourmaline became the holy stone of the God IGA. And I still have my chunk from back then.

Mithgiladan

It was early in the Swamp, I can't recall exactly when, perhaps 1982 or 1983. I was suddenly grabbed from behind, lifted off the ground, with a hand clapped over my mouth, and carried off through the woods. There were several kidnappers, including the **huge, strong man who was carrying me off through the woods**. I had no idea what was going on. I remember my toes lightly grazing the ground as I was forcibly carried away. I am a large woman and this just does not happen! Eventually, I was brought to Pug Mahon, the Seneschal and/or Baron, of Carillion, who declared his undying love for me, in his broad theatrical manner. He said he would never let me go and could not live without me. He would **declare WAR on the SWAMP** to keep me. The joke was that I was held captive my being drugged with magnificent chocolates (see the picture on page 23). A battle was fought in Carillion and the Swamp reclaimed its Baroness. In 1983, Swampies took a road trip to the Higgins Armory in New Hampshire. Irik and Merlinia were leading this trip and chatted with the museum staff. After explaining the SCA and their intense interest in all things medieval, the staff took them to a private area and allowed Irik to try on a full suit of armor. Lydia tried on a helmet and gauntlets. Note: Sadly, the Higgins Armory closed in 2013. Ursula

Greetings and Salutations from IRIK and Merlynia, Baron and Baroness of Settmoure Swamp,





The Founding of House Bheithir as told by Dylan

Reprinted from the 10 year Anniversary Mudpuppy, August 1989





November 11th, 1984. 10:30 pm. It was a dark and stormy night. (it was, really!) There was me, that is Dylan, and my freind, Cuthbadh busily driving home from dance class at the home of Ursula, then Baroness of Settmour Swamp. We had all evening been dicussing the fate of the then fledgling Canton of BlackOak (Cranbury, East Windsor, Princeton area) and had met with little success. At the time, neither the Barony of Settmour Swamp or the Barony of Carillion was willing to release the zip codes of those areas allowing us to finalize our efforts. So there we were, mulling this over, wondering what to do. Finally, as we neared the Princeton Airport, Cuthbadh burst forth with the First Revelation and Now First Rule of House Bheithir. "Hell with the politics, we're going to have fun!" And such, on that one statement, House Bheithir was born. The rest is history. In the intervening years since then, House Bheithir (The House of the Beast) has distinguised itself by coining the phrase "House Lestoil, the Armor Cleaner", having our name and device registered by Laurel King of Arms (Vert, a pall inverted ermine, three boars' heads caboshed argent, eyes in gules) and producing two Seneschals, several Autocrats, the best BellyDancers ever seen, and more plaid than you've ever seen in your life. From the start, Bheithir was primarily devoted to those of the Celtic persuasion, now, we recruit our members who are of the same mind as that edict spoken by Cuthbadh many years ago. The SCA, above all, should be fun. "When something ceases to become fun, and more like the mundane world, what the hell's the point?"Below is a sequential listing of those in Bheithir and there approximate persona. Slainte' Heltega', Tuatha de Settmour.



Entertainments

In the early years of the Swamp, when the events were relatively small, we often performed period plays and/or silly plays that told legends of the Swamp. The period plays were often household comedies by Hans Sachs, like "The Hot Iron". At a Roman event, we performed a version of the ancient Greek play, Lysistrata. (see photos on page 17).

As events became larger, we changed to **SPECTACLES**, which do not require good acoustics. 4/5/1986 Coronation of Ron and Bronwyn: A startled hush fell over the crown as a **dragon** entered and threatened the King and Queen. Ceara attacked the dragon's tail and Irik slayed the dragon.

At Mudthaw 1994, Baroness Merlynia defeated the dragon by "**taking a leek**". This adventure was turned into a song by Teleri:






