We may get to an event or two before then, but if we don't see you before, we hope to see you at Pennsic.



A & S Project of the Month Limuwiya

Artist: Dom. Galefridus Peregrinus, MKA Lon Mendelsohn

Project description: (What time period; region is it from?)

Limuwiya, a 13th Century Baghdad recipe (although it probably originated earlier in Persia).

Why did you choose to take on this project?

I've been looking at medieval Arab cookery over the past couple of years, focusing as much on how things were cooked in the medieval Arab kitchen as on the recipes themselves. I've also been working on designing medieval-like Arab recipes, but that wasn't the focus of this project. I prepared the dish using methods that have been in use in North Africa and Southern Spain for millennia.

Difficulty level: (beginner, intermediate, advance) Intermediate.

What materials are needed to complete this project?

All of the ingredients for the recipe are grocery store items, except for two of the spices: Rose Water, and Mastic. Both of these are available at ethnic markets or specialty stores.

How long did it take to complete? (or how long you've been working on it if it is not complete?) Including the time needed to research and document the recipe and cooking technique, I spent about two months working on this project. Once I had decided on the recipe, the actual time spent preparing, cooking, and evaluating the results took about six hours for each of the three times that I prepared the recipe.

What sources if any did you use as your basis for this project?

The recipe itself came from the *Kitab al-Tabikh* of al-Baghdadi. Several original sources, some dating from as early as the 10th Century, verified the use of clay cooking pots and braziers to prepare such recipes.
